

Biography - Terry Rout



Terry Rout is a Senior Lecturer in the School of Computing and Information Technology at Griffith University, Queensland, Australia and is associated with the Software Quality Institute at the University. He lectures in areas of software engineering, software quality and project management, and has directed the student project course in the School's degree program since its inception.

He is Chair of the Australian Committee for Software Engineering Standards, and has been a member of the Australian delegation to the International Committee on Software Engineering Standards since 1992. He has been a member of the international Management Board for the SPICE (Software Process Improvement and Capability dEtermination) Project since its inception, working towards the development and validation of an international standard for software process assessment. He is Manager of the Southern Asia Pacific Technical Centre established to provide a regional focus for this work, and is the overall Project Editor for ISO/IEC TR 15504 - Software Process Assessment.
